




Did you know . . .?







American's first movie theatre was opened in Pittsburgh in 1905. The admission was five cents so it was called the "Nickelodeon."


## BALLOONING OVER PENNSYLVANIA'S COUNTRYSIDE














STATE BIRD: RUFFED GROUSE



STATE FLOWER: MOUNTAIN LAUREL






STATE DOG: GREAT DANE



STATE INSECT: FIREPLY




STATE TREE: HEMLOCK
